## RECOGNITION OF THE BEST GRADES

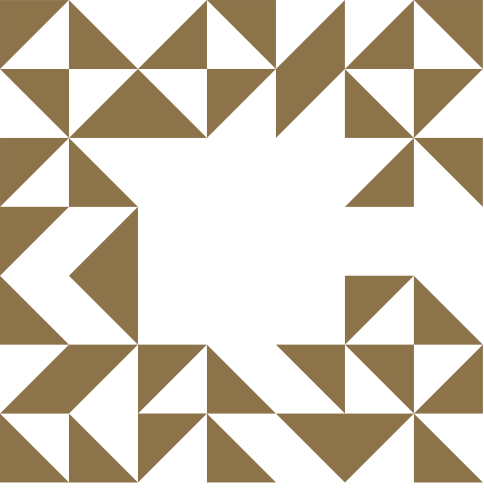

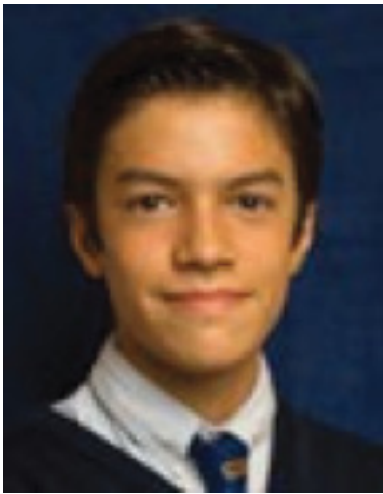
